As the Spring opens up in its blooms, and the sun shines brighter and warmer, it's easy to reflect on God's wonderful creation. And if we read about the creation in Scripture, we will find something perhaps unexpected. Take, for example, Psalm 148, a Psalm of Praise, which says,

"Praise the Lord! Praise the Lord from the heavens!

... Praise Him, sun and moon!

Praise Him, all you shining stars!

... Praise Him from the earth, you great sea creatures and all deeps,

Fire and hail, snow and mist, stormy wind fulfilling His Word!

Mountains and all hills,

Fruit trees and all cedars!

Beasts and all livestock,

Creeping things and flying birds!"

But we might wonder... how does the sun and moon, how does your dog or your cat, how does fire and ice praise the Lord!? It's a strange thing for us to think since we equate praising God as using our mind and lifting up our voice in song and prayer. But this is a good reminder that praising the Lord is also work well done that is pleasing to the Lord.

So, when the snow and the mist come according to God's Word, they are in fact praising the Lord even though they are inanimate objects, because they are fulfilling His Word. When your cat catches that mouse and your dog flops over for you to rub his belly, they are praising the Lord because they are carrying out the tasks God has given for them to do. When the sun rises, it's praising the Lord! When the moon sets, it's praising the Lord! That's exactly the task God has given them to do.

So, what does that mean for us? When we carry out the work God has given us to do, we, too, are praising the Lord. When we set the meal on the table for our children, we are praising the Lord. When we finish our homework or the task our boss gave us, we are praising the Lord. When we tend the garden in the backyard or change our oil and maintain our equipment well, we are praising the Lord.

These things seem mundane, but if they are in line with what God desires from us: that we show His love in the world and treat the world and His gifts with respect and care, we are praising the Lord, just as the creation praises Him.

Certainly there are things that we do every day that don't praise the Lord. Those are sin. When we're lazy or unwilling to do a task, when we complain or grumble or gossip, none of that is praising the Lord. But when we do our tasks well and with gratitude, then even the most mundane thing in the world can be turned into praise for the Lord.




